GENERAL ORDER NUMBER 2, SERIES 2025-2026

To: The Officers of the Grand Commandery of Knights Templar of Oklahoma,
The Past Grand Commanders of the Grand Commandery of Knights Templar of Oklahoma,
The Officers and Sir Knights of the Constituent Commanderies of Knights Templar of Oklahoma,
and to whom it may concern.

This General Order consists of the procedure for Cornerstone Ceremonies for this Grand Chevalric year.

The following procedure will be followed for all Cornerstone Ceremonies for this Grand Chevalric year.

1. The Grand Marshal from the M.·. W.·. Grand Lodge of A.·.F.·. & A.·.M.·. of the State of Oklahoma will notify the Grand Commander or the Grand Recorder of a request to participate in a Cornerstone Ceremony.
2. If the request is made to the Grand Recorder, he shall notify the Grand Commander. Upon the Grand Commander's approval, the Grand Recorder will email all Sir Knights asking for help with the request.
3. All Sir Knights who wish to participate will contact Sir Knight Ryan Frederick by email at ryanfrederick@gmail.com or by text at 785-643-3683.
4. If there are four (4) or more Sir Knights who have volunteered to help, Sir Knight Frederick will notify the Grand Commander, and he shall notify the Grand Marshal.
5. If there are fewer than four (4) Sir Knights who have volunteered, the Grand Commander will notify the Grand Marshal that we will not be able to participate in the Cornerstone Ceremony.


Under no circumstances will we participate with fewer than four (4) Sir Knights.

Also, no Sir Knight, or constituent Commandery, is to randomly show up and participate as a Sir Knight in a Cornerstone Ceremony without prior authorization from the Grand Commander.

This General Order will be read at the first Stated Conclave following receipt. The Recorder will document the reading in the minutes of the Stated Conclave.
